RE: **CURBSIDE RECYCLING SERVICE**

It's here! Curbside collection of recyclables is now available in the Village and this is what you need to know in order to participate:

This is a subscription service and you must contact Waste Management to establish the service for your residence. You will be instructed to pick up your recycling bin from the Village Office once you have enrolled. Recyclables will be collected bi-weekly on Tuesdays and the first collection is scheduled for November 18th. Bins must be at the curb by 7:00 am.

Charges will be billed quarterly. The following costs will be included:

Monthly service charge	\$4.50 (\$13.50 per quarter)
Fuel Surcharge*	<i>approximately 15% of service charge currently (about \$2.00 per quarter at this time)</i>
Administration fee**	\$2.00 per invoice

At about \$17.50 per quarter with biweekly collections the cost per collection is approximately \$2.70.

**This charge will fluctuate based on the cost of diesel fuel.*

***If you currently subscribe to other Waste Management services, such as yard waste, your bills will be combined and you will pay only one admin. fee per invoice.*

The items collected include boxboard, newspaper, magazines, glass, tin and plastic. A complete list appears on the flyer included with this letter.

“NEW” 2-SORT RECYCLE with ONE 18-GALLON BIN

“NEW” 2-SORT RECYCLE SYSTEM

- WM sorts the paper from the containers in the recycle truck.
- Please tuck paper to one side of bin and containers to the other.
- Prepare recyclables according to the guidelines listed here.
- Place bin at the curb, before 7:00 AM, on your regular collection day.

Place the following to one side of the recycle bin:

BOXBOARD - Includes cereal, tissue, and shoe boxes, beer and pop cases. **No cardboard**, waxed or plastic-lined boxes, freezer cartons or egg cartons.



MAGAZINES & CATALOGS

NEWSPAPER & AD INSERTS

Including all inserts that come with the newspaper.



MIXED OFFICE PAPER – Includes white and colored stationery, envelopes, legal paper, computer and copier paper, blue prints and note book paper. **No glossy paper, fax paper, self adhesive note paper, window envelopes, paper towels, tissue or carbon papers.**

Place paper to one side of bin either loose or in a brown paper grocery bag. Do not place items in plastic grocery bags. please.

Place the following **CONTAINERS** to one side of bin:

TIN, ALUMINUM & STEEL CONTAINERS – Food containers only. Rinse and place loose in recycle bin.



#2 PLASTIC BOTTLES – Look for the #2 (HDPE) on the small-mouthed bottles including milk jugs, detergent bottles and personal care products. **NO** wide-mouth containers, such as margarine tubs. **No** bottles that held motor oil or other toxic fluids. Rinse and flatten. Remove and discard caps. Place loose in *recycle bin*.



CLEAR GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS, rinse and discard lids. Place loose in recycle bin.

#1 PLASTIC BOTTLES – Look for the #1 (PET) on the bottom of clear and transparent green bottles. Includes spring water, salad dressing, liquor and mouthwash. **Please rinse, discard cap and flatten**. Place loose in recycle bin.
